

largest fundraiser, the 16th Annual G.A.L.A. (Gatherings Across a Large Area) as a series of smaller gatherings held at the homes of community members within their trusted pods, but connected together online in honor of our own frontline workers, our faculty and staff. Thanks to the faculty members and students who put together music videos and to our seniors, who recorded video messages for the G.A.L.A. guests. The evening netted over \$200,000 that went to support our operating budget and benefit our students.

The Gala, combined with other fundraisers such as the Summer Double Dip, An IDEAL Day of Golf, 5K Your Way, and other efforts brought \$744,882.50.

Many times over the year, I was in the room as my son attended his classes, virtual dances and get-togethers, and school assemblies. I witnessed the power of inclusion and saw that no student was left out of the conversation, the lesson, or the fun, not by t4eachers and not by other students.

Your support enables us to fund this unique program. As important as outside donors are to continuing our mission, our IDEAL school community proved their commitment to our mission with overall donations to The Pioneer Fund reaching 91% for families and 100% for faculty and staff. Giving financially, while giving of themselves every day, is proof positive that our faculty and staff are simply the best.

We on the Board have had to learn a lot since March 2020. Like everyone, we navigated uncharted waters, learning as we went. I greatly appreciate the work of our Board, but especially the work that our faculty and staff did to make the school operate on a day to day basis throughout this trying time.





We kept our IDEAL traditions in a modified form throughout the year, initially assembling only on Zoom, but later coming together in person in larger groups for our Senior Dinner and Graduation. Our largest senior class yet saw 13 students move up to college and postsecondary programs including our Next Steps Transition Program. I am proud to shar that our seniors earned over \$950,000 in scholar dollars and added many more schools to our impressive list of acceptances and matriculated to schools including Colgate university, Emerson College, Syracuse University: InclusiveU, and further afield at the University of South Carolina Aiken and Xavier University of Louisiana.

Though challenged in so many ways by the pandemic, we held together as a community, whether attending dances on Zoom or modifying school sports to align with social distancing standards. Families attended the annual Civil Rights Museum and ArtBeat online and our teachers and students developed innovative ways to share their work in this forum. We even created the inclusive, virtual 5K Your Way, welcoming participants from an expanded community to take advantage of the limitless opportunities of a virtual event. More than 200 people joined our 5K and also made contributions to The Pioneer Fund.

We hope that we can always teach all of our students inside our buildings and welcome in families to join our traditions, but I want to give my thanks to everyone who continues to do their part to adapt to our current circumstances. We have never lost sight of the importance of inclusion and equity in our school and the world at large. Thank you for teaching, supporting, donating, and volunteering. Together we are IDEAL.



THE OPEN DOOR SCHOLARSHIP FUND

DEAL's student community reflects the rich diversity of New York City, and we are extremely proud of our extensive socioeconomic diversity. The Open Door Scholarship Fund, established in 2010, allows us to continue to provide access to an independent school education for students from under-resourced communities. Every dollar donated to the Open Door Scholarship Fund goes directly toward the tuition of students in the Standard Program.

We seek individual, corporate, and foundation partners to support this effort by funding scholarships for children in need. More than 48% of IDEAL students receive tuition assistance, and the average financial aid award is 89% of tuition. This represents an investment of approximately \$4.8 million annually, approximately 28% of the school's expenditures. Open Door Scholarship funding allows the school to continue to invest meaningfully in the program and to meet the needs of our diverse student body. Thanks to the generosity of donors to the Fund, our Open Door Scholars are thriving.


